Waste Management Options – On-Farm Guide

Silage Wrap, Feed & Seed Bags, Twine - Plasback

Plasback provides recycling liners for:

- Silage wrap (≈200 round bale wraps per full liner)
- Polypropylene feed & seed bags
- HDPE drums
- Baling twine

Important: Each waste stream must go in its own liner.

Liners and bins can be purchased online (or build your own bin).

Plastic Containers – AgRecovery

- 70+ collection sites nationwide; collection events in other areas.
- Free recycling for 3,000+ approved products (labels must stay on).
- Containers must be empty and triple-rinsed before drop-off.
- On-farm pickup available for >300 containers.

Plastic Drums

- Clean drums can be reused for storage/transport.
- Agrecovery: free collection for many brands; others collected for a fee.
- **Plasback:** collects 100–200 L HDPE Ecolab and Agpro drums (good condition).

Fertiliser Bags

- Some larger scale fertiliser companies offer take-back recycling at their stores.
- Contact your supplier for details.

<u>Agrichemicals - Safe Disposal (Agrecovery)</u>

- Includes herbicides, pesticides, fungicides, vet meds.
- Many chemicals free to dispose; others subsidised.
- Book disposal online after completing a chemical inventory.

Dead Stock Disposal

- <u>Collection services:</u> quick, simple, environmentally sound.
- Offal pits: must meet council rules (distance from waterways, dairy, boundaries).

For more information on offal pit requirements, refer to the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan.

Composting: low-odour, cost-effective (use sawdust/straw layers).

Tyres

- Reuse for securing silage stacks.
- Burning is illegal.
- **Tyrewise** offers legal, consented collection & recycling.
- There are multiple public collection sites across Canterbury.

Used Oil

- Many mechanics take waste oil during servicing.
- Supercheap Auto: free drop-off at stores.

Batteries

- Drop off at petrol stations, garages, council waste sites.
- Scrap metal recyclers often pay per kg for lead-acid batteries.
- Seal leaking batteries in a bag.
- **Battery Zone Ashburton:** drop off old batteries here to ensure your battery is recycled properly.

Treated Timber

- Should be disposed of at approved landfills.
- Can be reused on farm if not in contact with animals/groundwater.
- Untreated timber can be burned or reused.
- Pallets can often be returned for credit.

Scrap Metal

- Recyclable through scrap dealers (often paid for).
- Contact your local scrap metal dealer for more information.
- Options for metal recycling in Ashburton:
 - Metalcorp Ashburton (03 308 6930)
 - Mid Canterbury Metal Recycling (03 308 8959)

Needles & Syringes

- Place in puncture-proof container and label biohazard waste.
- Take to a vet or provider accepting sharps.

Paint

Takeback schemes: return leftover or unwanted paint for recycling.

- Resene PaintWise
- Dulux Paint Take Back

Green waste

Some green waste (vegetation, paper, cardboard, untreated wood, crop residue) can be burnt. For rules around outdoor burning, refer to the Canterbury Air Regional Plan, Rule 7.10-7.19.
